Nokomis Research, a Division of Skytree Naturals, Awarded Patent for Hormonal Regulation

Scottsdale, Arizona – March 31, 2018 – Skytree Naturals is pleased to announce the recent issuance of U.S. Patent #9,333,184, Composition and Method for Affecting Male and Female Hormone Levels, to its Research division, Nokomis Research Inc.

This naturally-based supplement is the result of a clinical trial and a homeopathic proving conducted to determine the impact of two biogenic polyamines on the internal hormonal messaging systems of healthy males and females.

These messaging systems consist of hormones produced naturally by the body in the endocrine glands. They carry information and instructions to every tissue; aid in recovery from injuries and in the resistance of diseases; and are responsible for successful development, normal behavior, and maintenance of normal body processes including reproduction. As well, they monitor and manage the repair and maintenance of muscles, bones, blood vessels, skin, and every other system in the body.
